PARISH REGISTRATION: We welcome new parishioners to share fully in our Parish life. As new members you bring vitality and growth to our parish. Registration forms are available in the clear magazine racks in each of the entrances of the Church. You may call the Parish Office to have a registration form mailed to you or stop by and complete a registration form at the Parish Office. You may also use the Parish web site iopnc.org to register online, **please call to confirm that your online registration was received.**

BAPTISM: Parental Attendance at a Preparation Class for the first child to be baptized is mandatory. The Baptism class takes place at 1:30PM in the Parish Hall on the last Sunday of the month and in Spanish on the **1st Wednesday of the month at 7PM** in the Library of the Parish Hall. **If you are requesting the baptism be in Spanish you will be required to attend the Spanish Baptism Instruction Class.** Pre-registration is not required. To have your child baptized you must meet the following requirements (1) *be a registered parishioner for at least three months* (2) *be practicing the faith* (3) *have obtained the signed Godparent Eligibility form and returned them to the Parish Office.* Please check the bulletin monthly for possible changes of class dates. Parents planning to have children baptized in the near future can contact the Parish Office in advance to obtain Godparent Eligibility Forms, these forms will need to be returned to the Parish Office before any baptism date will be scheduled. **MARCH BAPTISM CLASS WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, MARCH 24TH.**

MARRIAGE: Arrangements must be made with a Parish Priest at least six months before your requested date. *To be married at Infant of Prague you must be a registered member of our Parish for at least six months.*

RCIA & SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION FOR ADULTS

Eager for a refresher about the Catholic faith? Interested in exploring the rich intellectual and spiritual tradition of the Church? Accompanying our seekers as a Sponsor or Faith Guide? Then please join us at our **weekly RCIA session Sunday from 12:15 – 1:30 PM in the Parish Hall!** The next session is on March 10th: "The Communion of Saints; The Spiritual Combat: Angels and Demons". (NOTE: *This is the last RCIA session before the Easter Vigil*)

NEW: What is going on in the RCIA?

We continue with the Scrutinies during the 10:30am Masses on the 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent. The **Second Scrutiny** will be celebrated on Sunday, March 10th - you will notice that we will be using the readings from Year A - #988 in the "One in Faith" book (instead of Year B). "The Second Scrutiny takes its inspiration from the Gospel story of the man born blind. As the Elect continue on their path to Baptism, we pray that the light of Christ will heal them from the darkness of sin and lead them to see that Christ is the light of the world. In Baptism, they will receive the light of Christ. This scrutiny helps prepare them - and

the parish community - to take and keep that flame of faith entrusted to us at Baptism burning brightly as we journey to the halls of heaven at the end of our lives here on earth." (from "One in Faith")

The **Third Scrutiny** will be celebrated on Sunday, March 17th and the readings for Year A, #991, are proclaimed. "The Third Scrutiny focuses the attention of the Elect on Christ, who is the resurrection and the life. Inspired by the moving story of the raising of Lazarus, the Elect come to terms with the death-dealing power of sin in their lives and in the evil that often pervades our world. The community of faith supports the Elect in prayer. Through the celebrant's praying of the prayer of exorcism and the laying on of hands (characteristics of all three Scrutinies), the Church asks God to deliver the Elect from the power of sin and Satan." (from "One in Faith")

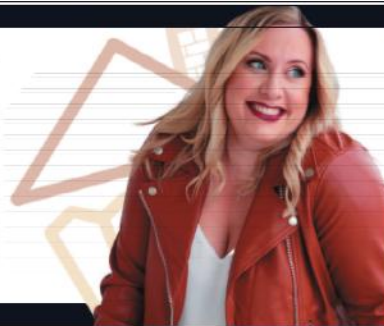
